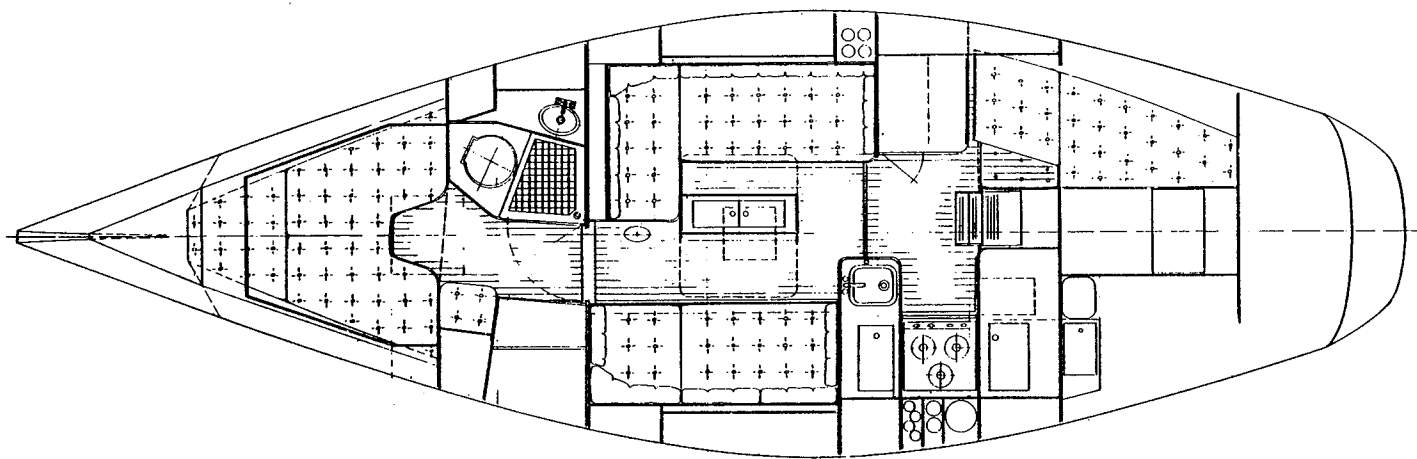
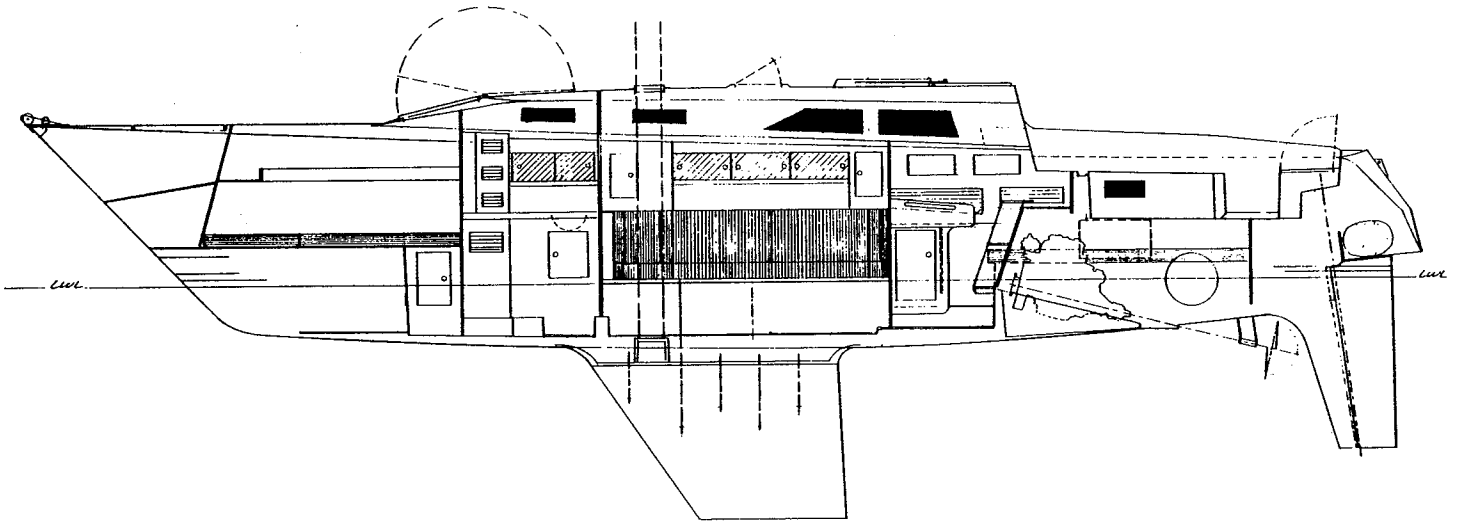


*The Sceptre 36 deck-plan shows how well inboard the shrouds are footed, leaving good deck space out-board and putting the genoa tracks against the house, well out of the way. Provisions have been made to lead all lines aft to the cockpit, and you'd have to look far and wide to find as much good light as provided here for belowdecks.*



*The profile of the Sceptre 36 shows a narrow sloop and fin keel, and that easily recognizable chopped transom. The interior plan has luxuriously deep settees, a good chart table and fine galley whose usable space is extended aft below the cockpit for extra stowage of rubbish and ice. The forepeak is made good and useful with a seat and ample floor space.*
